

In June 2019, eight Sisterhood girls – including TV presenter Helen Skelton - will relay swim the English Channel in aid of The Sick Children's Trust.

Sisterhood founder Emma Sayle had a rollercoaster start to 2019 with her 4-month old baby being rushed to The Royal London Hospital and intubated for 10 days. The Sick Children's Trust gave Emma a bed and support. She raised over £5000 during those 10 days for the charity and with over half the team being mums, they felt strongly that the swim should be in aid of this amazing charity.
